Hello Friends!

What a wild ride this school year turned out to be! While it started out as usual, it ended very differently. This was definitely a year of transition in more ways than one.

Our corporate fundraising was very successful this year. We were thrilled to welcome Facebook to Sunnyvale and add them to our list of corporate donors. Longtime supporters Google, LinkedIn, Bosch and Sares Regis continued to support our ongoing programs and a \$100,000 directed donation from Google helped bridge the access gap when the district closed campuses in March and switched to distance learning. By year end, corporate donations totaled \$205,000, an increase of 260 percent over last year. Even without the pandemic-related grant, corporate donations were up 95 percent over last year.

Our support from community sources, parents and other community members, was down this year. We raised \$27,100, a decrease of 8 percent from the previous year. We did have our annual year-end campaign in December, but clearly the cancellation of our March event had an impact. We are already anticipating that we will not be able to hold this event in March 2021 and are making alternate arrangements.

We distributed \$27,500 in school grants at the beginning of the 2019-20 school year, in addition to the \$100,000 distance-learning grant at the end of the school year. Following our standard practice, we also granted \$15,000 in the spring for the science camp this year. For the first time, we allocated funds raised the previous year, which allowed us to give the principals early notification of the amount each school would receive at the beginning of the school year. We followed that model again, and allocated \$85,000 in school grants for the 2020-21 school year.

SEF turned five this year, and we have never been in a stronger position. Despite the challenges of the pandemic, the board has continued to operate smoothly and adapt our work to a new reality. I am humbled by the dedication and energy that our board members bring, and am excited to work with them to face the challenges in the coming year.
