# HELLO FRIENDS

If you're reading this, then hopefully you're already familiar with some of what the Sunnyvale Education Foundation (SEF) has accomplished since our founding in 2015, when a group of parents, educators, and community leaders established a charitable nonprofit focused on enriched, high-quality education for all students in Sunnyvale School District. In 2021-2022, SEF contributed \$128,500 for enrichments, taking schooling beyond the basics for the 6,000 students in Sunnyvale School District.

SEF raises funds and advocates for arts and music, after school programs, STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math), science camp, whole child wellness, outdoor learning, JEDI resources (justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion), and volunteerism. In collaboration with school leaders, SEF also provides intangibles, helping identify and fulfill needs across the district, and engaging and connecting administrators, teachers, staff, and parent groups, crossing school boundaries to spread ideas and insights.

SEF is uniquely positioned to help our schools sustain "the fun stuff" for students even as Sunnyvale schools experience a mix of new and old challenges and opportunities. With the support of our donors, SEF secures timely funding and resources to help students have continued access to engaging educational programs. This year SEF added a special projects fund to invest in larger enrichment goals. SEF is also taking the lead, in partnership with the school district, on fundraising for 5th grade science camp.

Sunnyvale Education Foundation is proud to contribute to a brighter future for all of our children and by extension all of us, through greater sustained access to enriched learning opportunities. We appreciate your support in these endeavors.
